The following is all the information needed to be considered a candidate. Please follow the instructions below carefully, and email your completed application rpaolillo@draws.com by:

Wednesday. March 25, 2020 at 5:00pm (EST). Late applications will not be accepted considered.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must be currently enrolled in or entering into a two-year or four-year college undergraduate program or graduate program to study a construction-related discipline (for example: construction management, architecture, civil, mechanical, structural or electrical engineering, interior design, landscape design). Students may be attending a college or university on a full-time or part-time basis.

AWARDS

- The number of scholarships and the cash value of each award will be determined each year by the PWC Board of Directors.
- Scholarships are awarded for one academic year only. Recipients may re-apply each year providing evidence of
 continued interest in construction, and continued enrollment and good standing in a construction industry related
 discipline.
- Preference will be given to students who plan to attend school within the 6 New England States (CT, MA, VT, NH, ME. And RI)

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Complete the application form below. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- Include an official copy of your school transcript. If your school requires that transcripts be sent directly to us, please have them sent to:

- Include (2) letters of recommendation. The first letter must be from your professor, guidance counselor, or academic advisor. The second letter can be from a teacher, coach, employer, clergy member, or another adult who knows you, but is not a family member.
 - Note: Letters must have been written within the 6 months prior to submition of your application. Letters
 must be typed or neatly written, be on official letterhead, and contain the writer's full name, title, address,
 and phone number.
- Include an essay (300 words or less) which explains how your planned studies will relate to a career in the construction industry and what event or series of events has led you to pursue a career in the A/E/C industry.. Your essay should focus on your desire to enter into one of the A/E/C professions and address why you are a good candidate for the award. Applicants who have previously received PWC scholarships must update your essay (and application) to reflect your current course of study and experiences each year that you apply. In addition to an essay, you are also invited to submit a video and/or photograph of yourself.
